REPORTS AND PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEWS

After consulting with parents we have made some changes to our reporting process this year.

Reports will go out a full week before the end of term. The portfolio with samples of student work has been replaced by a showcase /student conference evening where you are invited to make an appointment with your child and sit with them as they share their work and their goals in the classroom. A maximum of 6 students will be booked in at any one time slot. The times slots are for 20 minutes and can be booked on line. Following these opportunities to read your child's report, sit with your child and see their work in the classroom, you are invited to make an appointment to meet with your child's teacher early next term. The student mid year reports will be distributed on Friday 23rd June.

FIRST AID CLASS FOR STUDENTS



St John Ambulance will visit our school on 26th and 27th June to deliver free First Aid in Schools training to our students. Through the First Aid in Schools program, trained St John presenters lead students from Foundation – Year 6 through tailored sessions on the importance of First Aid and what to do in the event of an emergency.

Our junior students learn about how to identify when there is an emergency, keeping themselves safe, and how to call for an ambulance. Senior students learn about delivering CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and the things they can do to assist in an emergency.

- Combined Training which involves Show Jumping and a Dressage Test.

During these tests, a judge (in a car!) scores the rider and the pony on their ability to complete different activities – such as moving in a straight line, keeping the pony's neck and rider's back straight etc.
