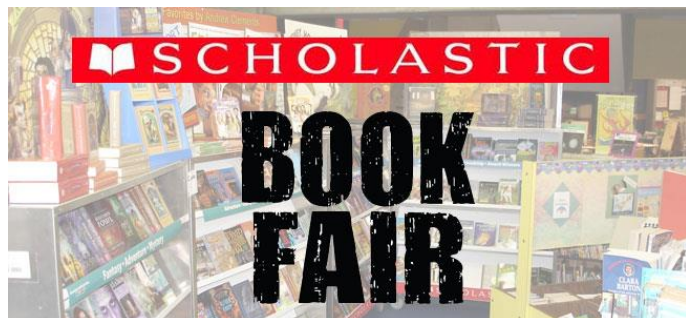
Thank you to everyone for your support of school fundraising efforts. Your great efforts will see some improvements around the school very soon.

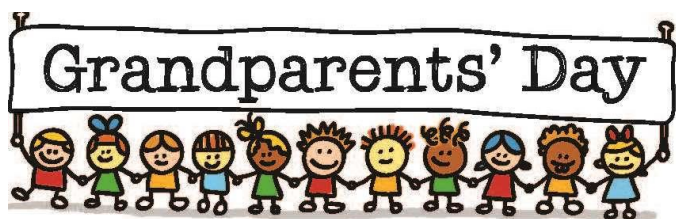

Journey into Play



Rosebud Toy Library is excited to be hosting "Journey into Play" to run an interactive session on creating inviting play spaces for parents and educators.

Journey Into Play is a professional development and consultancy organisation for the early childhood sector. They believe in providing collaborative and inclusive environments, rich in open materials, enabling children to feel empowered to explore, investigate and experiment.

To attend one of their sessions would normally cost \$85 per person but we are very excited to be able to offer this great session at a drastically reduced cost thanks to the hard work of our fundraising team who have secured a grant towards this great training opportunity.

Parents who are toy library members can attend this session for \$10, Educators who are Toy Library Members can attend for \$25 and for Educators who are not members it is \$35. Educators will be issued with a Professional Development Certificate.

Do you struggle to create truly inviting play spaces for the children in your care?

Inviting play spaces are the places we provide for our children where they are free to follow their own agendas and unrestricted by adult expectations. Spaces where adults provide unspoken permission for play ... the kind of environments we all loved playing in when we ourselves were children ...

Playing with the repurposed items and natural materials. The kind of things that are really, really cheap to buy, fun to scavenge and often free, including of course incorporating things you already have at hand. Items of little or no value to adults but in a child's eyes are treasures!!

This topic includes a hands-on playing component.
